



Scavenger Hunt

Rules and Regulations

- Delegates: 3 minimum, 5 maximum
- All team members need to stay with their team at all times. You may not split up to “divide” scavenger hunt tasks.
- Teams must be courteous and respectful to their teammates and all the outside people involved in the scavenger hunt.
- Consists of 3 rounds (in order of increasing difficulty level)
- Plagiarism/cheating is not allowed (elimination may occur)

Round guide

Round 1: “Riddles”

Time: 1 hour 30 minutes

How it works?

- Riddles will be displayed on multimedia.
- This is a buzzer round
- The team solving the most riddles will win this round
- There will be ten riddles all together

Round 2: “Explore”

Time: 2 hours

- 20 flags will be hidden at different places around the campus
- Each flag has 1 mark
- Delegates are supposed to collect all the flags before the time runs out
- Team unable to find at least 10 items will be eliminated

Round 3: “Time is short!”

Time: 2 hours

- In this round you will have to conduct different tasks and activities in order to get to the next clue which earns you bonus points.



- No clue will be provided unless all the required tasks and activities are conducted by the delegation and are recorded and shown to the ushers.
- The first delegation to compete all the required tasks and activities to reach the final clue will be awarded as the winning team.

Note: Bring your 3g/4g devices to search clues on the internet.
