## Day 1 ROUND 1:

- Teams will submit documentaries in USBs before the round begins.
- Documentaries made by teams will be played on screen. They can choose either from the two topics:
  - Air pollution OR Water Crisis
- Each documentary will be allowed a maximum screen time of 5 minutes.
- These documentaries will be followed by a questionnaire about the documentary from the judges which may be answered by multiple team members.

## Round 2

- Teams will submit presentations (if made on power point) in USBs before the round begins.
- Teams may use physical charts/models if they need to.
- Each team will be given a limit of 10-15 minutes to present.
- Each presentation will be followed by a questionnaire from the judges about the presentation. Not all team members will be required to speak.

## Round 3

Teams will be provided with a topic on the spot. The topic will require the teams to take a specific stance or side. They will be given one hour of preparation time and then speak on the topic. Each team will speak for around 5-10 minutes. All members are not under compulsion to speak.
