



CHARADES

This is a performing arts event that encourages young minds to portray their emotions and mindsets using the skill of enactment. We expect you all to avail this opportunity as we will provide the platform you need for your skills to be recognized.

Round1: Act it out

- There is no limit to how many participants can belong in one team.
- There is no specific theme in this round .The phrases may either be quotations or titles of books, movies, plays, television shows and songs.
- No team should write down any phrase unless at least three participants in the team have heard of it.
- No foreign phrases are allowed.
- The actor has limited time of 2-3 minutes and if he/she gets it correct within the time limit, the team scores a point.
- The points are to be noted down on a separate score book and tallied by a member of the management.

Round 2: Theme "In Art"

- Teams qualified for this round will follow the following theme from Hollywood/Bollywood movies **only**.
- The team that will guess the phrase correctly in the allotted time will score the highest marks.
- The winner and runner up for this event will be dependent upon the score board judged and tallied by a member of the management.

Rules:

- No speaking. No pointing. No lip movements. Only "acting out" words or pantomiming similar sounding words will be allowed.
- A Charade card with a phrase given by one team will be revealed to a member of another team, who will then enact the specific phrase for the rest of her/his team members to guess.
- The team demonstrating the act will choose their actor. However, each participant in that team has to act once. The same participant will not be allowed to act again unless this has been complied with.
- The actors can make any gestures to act out the word.
- The guessers may ask the actor questions to which the actor may only respond with a nod or a shake.
- No phrase should be longer than seven words.
- Each team will be given time to write down the phrases separately at the start of the game.
